NATIONAL SOLAR TOUR: The 81-panel solar parking lot array at Second Presbyterian will again be a part of the National Solar Tour on October 1-2! During this two-day event, Second Presbyterian will be joining hundreds of homes, businesses and organizations across the nation to showcase their solar sites. Our 29.16 kW solar array generates about 39 megawatts annually, which is used to help power our 7,600-square-foot youth building. Any excess power that we generate is applied to the energy used by our main building. The American Solar Energy Society National Solar Tour is the largest grassroots solar, renewable energy, and sustainable living event in the nation. The tour allows solar owners and supporters to connect, ask and answer questions, and participate in a nationwide in-person and virtual solar experience. Check it out at www.nationalsolartour.org!


