

OUR ENDOWMENT AT WORK: MAY-DEAL SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY: The May and Deal families blessed our church by giving planned gifts to be used as scholarships for higher education. The Scholarship Committee is now accepting applications for the May-Deal Scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year. The requirements are as follows:

- Applicants shall be residents of Arkansas.
- Applicants shall need financial assistance for higher education.
- Applicants shall not be on full scholarship.
- Undergraduate applicants must be full-time students.

The application process is competitive for a fixed pool of scholarship funds. Usually, in-coming freshmen applicants need to be in the upper 20% of their high school class. Those already in college must be in good standing and on schedule to graduate with their freshman class. The application deadline for the 2023-2024 school year is **Friday, June 2, 2023**. Applications that are incomplete or late will not be considered. Applications are available in the church office and at www.secondpreslr.org. SPC ADULT CHOIR TOUR TO SPAIN

The Second Presbyterian Adult Choir will tour Spain, June 8-19. The Choir will leave on June 8, arriving in Madrid on June 9. They will sing their first concert in the *Iglesia Nuestra Senora de Los Angeles* in Madrid on June 10, and travel to Burgos on June 12. They have a concert in *Santa Tecla Chapel of the Burgos Cathedral* on June 13, and travel to Zaragoza on June 14, with a concert on June 15 in the *Iglesia San Gil*.

On June 16, they will travel to Barcelona, looking forward to entrance to the *Sagrada Familia*, the Barcelona cathedral which has been under construction since 1882, the largest unfinished Catholic Church in the world. Antoni Gaudi became architect of the structure in 1883, until his death in 1926. It is now estimated to be completed in approximately 2026. On November 7, 2010, Pope Benedict XVI consecrated the church and proclaimed it a minor basilica.

On June 17, the choir will visit the *Palau de la Musica*, and on June 18, they will present a concert in the *Basilica de la Merced* in Barcelona, leaving Barcelona to return to Little Rock on June 19.

The SPC Choir has been known to rehearse for all of their concerts and service participation in airports, in parks, on buses, on airplanes, on ferries, on boats, on trains and just about anywhere you can imagine. They look forward to many delightful tour experiences. The Choir appreciates those of you who have helped choir members who were less able to pay for this tour. Thank you!
