

### **Boy Scout Sunday**

### MORE ABOUT THE BOY SCOUTS AND SECOND PRESBYTERIAN

Organization of the Boy Scouts of America was completed February 8, 1913. It was inspired by and modeled after the Boy Scouts Association, established by Lord Robert Baden-Powell in Britain in 1908. An early change to the British program was the addition to the Scout Law of, "A Scout is brave, clean, and reverent." and Article III of the constitution of the BSA, now known as the religious principle, "Boy Scouts of America believes that no member can grow into the best kind of citizen without recognizing

Since its beginning it has been the largest organization for boys in the USA, and now accepts girls into the Cub and Scout programs with female leadership.

Boy Scout Troop 55 moved to Second Presbyterian Church in 2019 after a vacancy was created by the closing of Troop 604 which had been at Second Pres since 1977. In its 43 years 113 boys earned the rank of Eagle Scout. On June 8 of this year a celebration of the accomplishments of T604 and the 50th anniversary of T55 is planned. All boys and adult leaders associated with these two troops are urged to attend along with their guests. More information coming soon.
